Environment Report



Routemap

- National Church Grant: £15k received to help prepare a costed plan for Diocesan Synod to consider in November 2023.
- Having a costed plan should help to unlock an additional £100k of grant funding.
- Net Zero Working Party (NZWP): this is yet to be established and is separate from the Environment Working Group.



Environment Policy: Action Plan

- Procedures, e.g. EcoChurch, Tools, Training
- Minor investment, e.g. lighting, energy supply
- Major investment, e.g. heating, solar, heat pumps


Parish consultations for 2024 - 2025

- Diocesan Synod 15th July, finance will be the main item
- Budget consultation begins with PCCs first week in September
- Diocesan Synod 16th September
- Generosity Week begins Sunday 24th September
- Budget Consultation closes 23rd October
- 2024 Budget proposal to Diocesan Synod 25th November



Parish Share receipts 2013 to 2022

Parish Share 2013 to 2022 £k




This chart highlights:

- Parish Share receipts have been falling since 2017
- The impact of the pandemic in 2020 to 2022 and also the cost of living crisis
- The 2022 receipts are £679k
 or 15% lower than 2017



Unrestricted cash projection in £k 2022 to 2025



This chart assumes:

- no Parish Share growth
- current budgeted spend plus inflation

Such assumption would see:

- our cash reducing by £2.1million
- the operating deficit rise year-on-year

As a reminder:

- our cash reserve target is £1.9million
- we have £1.7m unrestricted reserves held as investments.



Parish Share shortfall

Parish Share Shortfall 2021 to 2025 in £k







This chart shows how the financial outlook could change if:

- Annual Parish Share grew by at least +5.0%.
- Annual cost inflation stabilised at +**2.0**%.

As a result this would help to reduce the shortfall.

High inflation continues to be a concern:

- 2021 was 5.4%
- 2022 was 10.05%
- 2023 is projected at 7.4%
