

Photography Tips



Make sure you get permission to take and share the photos – at least verbally for adults but in writing for children.



If you have a choice, try to take the photos in a space with good lighting with an uncluttered background.



Try to have your subjects fill the majority of the photo but if using a mobile phone, don't zoom in as this reduces quality. Instead, move closer.



Take a mix of photos which tell the story e.g. wide shots of the whole event, close-ups of faces and action shots e.g. someone lighting a candle.



Photos are better if subjects are smiling and facing the camera so take some posed for photos in addition to the candid ones mid-event.



Take more photos than you need to avoid having a blurry photo or eyes closed with no back-up.
