Training requirements	You must complete all safeguarding training up to the level of Safeguarding Leadership Learning, as well as Raising Awareness of Domestic Abuse.	
Support you will be given	Peer supervision with the Lead Officer	
Probationary Period	You will have a 6-month probationary period.
